Networking visit from the Danish Ministry of Food, Agriculture and Fisheries

On 11 May 2024, the Ministry's unit for Nature & Agricultural Development visited the LIFE Wadden Sea Birds project to learn about the project's multifunctional approach to bird protecting measures to pursue Natura 2000 goals and climate adoption and how the instrument of land swap is a significant tool to reach the project's success in the project site Margrethe Kog.

Land Consolidation Planner Jacob Busch and Project Manager Jørgen Nicolaisen presented The LIFE project to a group of about 40 professionals for the Ministry's unit.

The unit implements land swap in e.g. wetland and lowland projects, purchases land for the projects and administers land owned by the Danish Agricultural Agency. The unit also administers the state's right of first refusal and the Agricultural Act - case management, policy and legislation.
